This allows people to encounter Jesus, many who would not normally be willing to attend a church service in a typical church setting full of strangers. Our goal is to establish smaller "churches" in neighborhoods where our evangelistic efforts are bearing fruit. In May, a woman gave her heart to the Lord and was healed! She is now a new member, and is growing in the Lord! In June, ICC was able to minister to a neighbor who lost her husband due to a terminal illness, leaving her to raise their teen children alone. We were able to visit her in her home the week after his death, to pray for her and her family. The following two Sundays, she and her extended family came to ICC services! It has been encouraging to see our members opening up their homes, amid Covid restrictions and other obstacles, making efforts to reach their own communities for Christ! The required masks, curfews, and other regulations have not hindered God's work, and we are honored to walk with ICC as they are SHARING THE VISION to reach their own "world". GREATER OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTNER IN MINISTRY:

STV usually hosts 5-7 short-term mission teams each year. The challenges of Covid in 2020 and 2021 have changed traveling abroad drastically. Many people are not willing to take foreign mission trips in these uncertain times. Much of the physical work on the DTC, we had hoped, would be done by mission teams. When the countr shut down, Jim worked by himself on the construction for almost 3 months. Once the country started to open up and some restrictions were lifted, the mission hired local laborers to help, but this was costly and not in our original budget. Helping hands and hearts came to the rescue!!! We were blessed to host CAF Team in the winter of 2020; they have such a heart for evangelism outreach. And in the summer of 2021, Crossroads Community Church sent their annual team, God's perfect timing and an answer to our fervent prayers! The CCC team held VBS ministries for our "campo" kids, who had not had any special activities since before the pandemic. This team worked so hard in the DTC construction project, and they truly have hearts to serve however and whenever needed. In late spring, our ICC Associate Pastor and his wife, Paulo and Erlandia Barbosa, sold their apartment in the city and purchased a corner piece of land at Hacienda Esperanza. They are currently building a small home and hope to move in by spring. Paulo works full time as a surgical assistant in the HOMS hospital in Santiago, but still devotes much time to the work of the Lord. He has such a shepherd's heart and God has done a beautiful work in their lives. They love to serve others and have giving hearts. They are a blessing to us and to our ICC church family. Our campo community have nicknamed him: Dr. Paulo!

GREATEST IS YET TO COME!!!

We are so blessed to be able to continue with the vision of building the Discipleship Training Center (DTC). It has not been easy, but God has shown grace in these turbulent times. We had already broken ground in late summer of 2019, and then traveled in the fall to raise funds toward the DTC Matching Fund. Praise God that through the generous donations of so many of you, STV was able to meet the goal set for the Matching Fund by the deadline of February 28, 2020. We were in full-on construction mode when the Covid-19 pandemic hit. Since then, building material prices have increased dramatically and our original construction budget is "out the window" ... The price of steel rises almost weekly. A report just came out that building material costs here in the Dominican Republic increased 32% and they predict it will continue to rise. Good News...GREAT NEWS! We are not discouraged! God continues to provide in so many ways. He has been faithful to give us wisdom and direction, guiding our decisions, showing us His grace and favor time and again.

We were able to put a roof over the second floor and construct two bathrooms on this second level. We hope to begin holding church services here at Hacienda Esperanza in October! Once again, God provided miraculously for this change from our original plan of finishing the first level completely. This allows us to begin using the building for ministry now, even as we are working toward completing the first floor, which is the actual DTC (Discipleship Training Center). The concrete floor of the first level is finished, excavation for the septic and clearing around the center was completed last week, the windows and doors were installed this week, and we are finishing the installation of the gutters for the water collection system tomorrow! The next stages of construction are: build interior walls, install drywall, prime and paint the interior and exterior walls, increase the 100-amp service currently at the warehouse to a 200-amp, so that we can install the 100-amp service for the DTC building, install the electrical wiring, and plumbing. (Lord willing, if the funds are available to do so.) What a testimony it will be if we can complete the first level and begin teaching and training students in the fall of 2022! We need helping hands for interior and exterior painting, metal stud and dry wall construction, interior plumbing, electrical work, 3000 square feet of ceramic tile to install, and more!

We are so grateful to all of you who have been a part of this ministry. Thank you for your prayers for us to walk in health, for God's provision, for fruitful ministry, for wisdom, and open doors to share the Good News. God's faithfulness has been exemplified through each of you. Thank you all for *Sharing The Vision* with us. And together, we will see the Discipleship Training Center become a reality.
